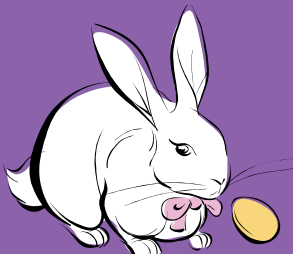

**REMINDER TO PET OWNERS -****Leash your pets & pick up pet waste.....**

AA Co. Animal Control Law - Article 12 Section 9-105, no pets are allowed to run at large. "At Large" means off the property of the animal owner, not leashed, & not under the control of a responsible person. The Law requires Dogs & Cats to be under the control of a responsible person & leashed at all times when they are off your property. Pet owners are responsible for the removal of pet waste on public sidewalks, private property, & recreation areas such as parks, paths, & beaches.

A safety issue that the MVACA would like to accomplish is to get additional lighting in Mago Vista Park to make it safer and more useful into the evening hours.
